ECO CLUB ANNUAL REPORT ACADEMIC YEAR 2022-2023



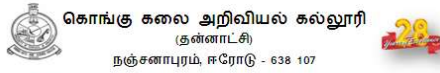
Activity-1

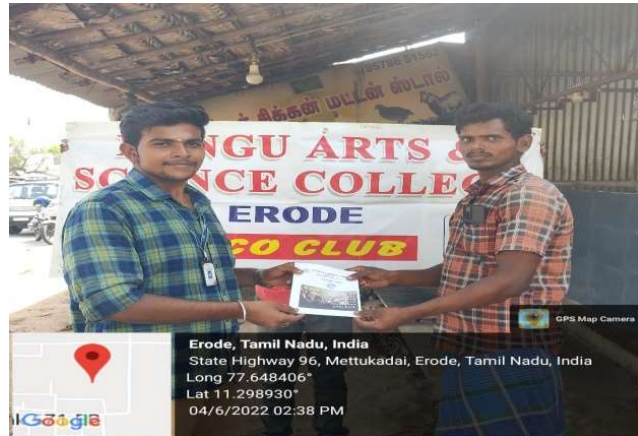


Activity-2

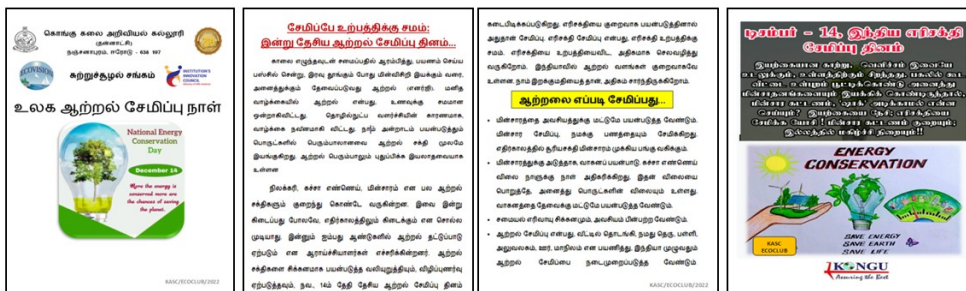
